



Direct to Film printing (DTF)

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DTG printing is a process that involves printing digital images directly onto garments using specialised direct to garment printers.

When supplying artwork for DTG printing, you will need to create & supply a high resolution image file in a compatible format such as PNG and JPEG files.

These are the most common file formats used for DTG printing, however, in some instances you can also use vector files such as EPS or PDF's.

When creating your artwork, always keep in mind that the quality of the print is very much dependant on the quality of the artwork supplied.

We recommended that you using high-resolution images with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi.

When saving art for DTG printing, the image will need a transparent background, otherwise, the image's background will be printed in white. This is especially the case if you plan to print on dark garments with white ink.

We recommend saving your print files as PNG's, as it is a universal format that allows you to maintain resolution preserve transparency.



To achieve the best possible print result, we suggest the following:

- Files should be supplied in PNG format with TRANSPARENT background.
- Files should be supplied to scale where possible
- Images should ideally be a minimum of 300dpi
